## EOSC 2019-2020: six action lines

**Architecture** 

Architecture of the federated infrastructures as the solution to the current fragmentation in research data infrastructures which are insufficiently interoperable.

Data

FAIR data management and tools. A common data language to ensure data stewardship across borders/disciplines based on FAIR principles.

**Services** 

Available services from a user perspective. A rich environment offering a wide range of services covering the needs of the users.

Access & Interface

Mechanisms/interfaces for accessing EOSC. A simple way for dealing with open data obligations or accessing research data across different disciplines.

**Rules** 

Rules of participation for different EOSC actors. An opportunity to comply with existing legal and technical frameworks and increase legal certainty & trust.

Governance

Governance of the EOSC, aiming at ensuring EU leadership in data-driven science but requiring new governance frameworks.



## Service dimension of the EOSC

### The EOSC will provide researchers with:

- ✓ A catalogue of European research data funded with public money;
- ✓ A catalogue of services to re-use these data;
- ✓ Tools to make their own data open and FAIR;
- ✓ Advanced tools to merge and analyse the data in a secure environment;
- ✓ A simple access gateway to these services (EOSC Portal).

# PRACE | scientific case

- First edition in 2012, update in 2018
- We cannot do it all
  - ▶ Which application domains to focus on?
  - ▶ Which technologies?
- Eternal struggle: heavenly Science vs mundane Economics
- Balance between traditional, disruptive and fundamental science





### The EU-ASEAN Policy Exchange Platform (PEP)

Long-term and continuous support measure and activity planning tool for region-to-region cooperation on an **expert working level**, and exchange between **working and policy level** 

In the first year of implementation of the PEP, studies and exchanges on **Talent Mobility**, **Regional Research Infrastructures** and on **HPC** are planned
